



Acacia has been growing in popularity due to its beautiful, warm grain pattern and character. When stained it can look very much like American Walnut, but is denser and much harder. This look is from what is called short leaf Acacia with a Janka hardness rating of around 2200, Big leaf Acacia on the other hand only rates at 1700 on the Janka scale. Our Acacia floors showcase the unique exotic grain in Natural and two warm earth tones. We also hand scrape it in a smooth time worn texture.
